

Subject: Amendment to Resolution 8300 for the Annexation of the Forty-Sixth Fringe Area to Eastern Municipal Water District and Metropolitan Water District

Report

The General Manager of Eastern Municipal Water District (Eastern) has reported that following receipt of your Board's Resolution 8300, which was adopted January 8, 1991 and fixed the terms and conditions for the concurrent annexation of the Forty-Sixth Fringe Area, certain delays have arisen which make it impossible to complete this annexation by December 31, 1991. Eastern has requested a time extension for completion of this annexation to December 31, 1992. The proposed use of this uninhabited territory will be for commercial and residential development.

The annexation comprises a gross area of 597.37 acres of which 77.47 acres are located within public streets, leaving a net area of 519.90 acres for calculation of the annexation charge pursuant to Section 3300 of Metropolitan's Administrative Code. The annexation charge, using the Per Acre Method applying the rate now in effect and a \$3,000 processing charge, amounts to \$435,556.80. If the Per Acre Rate is revised prior to completion of the annexation, the annexation charge will be recomputed using the new rate.

Informal Approval of this annexation was granted by Metropolitan's Board at its October 17, 1989 meeting. Since your Board first considered the annexation request prior to adopting the Water Use Efficiency Guidelines, Section 3107 of Metropolitan's Administrative Code, this annexation is not subject to the provisions of said Section.

Attached is a form of resolution amending Resolution 8300 by reaffirming all the previously fixed terms and conditions for the annexation with the exceptions that the completion date will be on or before December 31, 1992, and that the annexation charge will be recomputed pursuant to Section 3300 if the Per Acre Rate is adjusted prior to the completion of the annexation.

On January 8, 1991, your Board considered the Negative Declaration prepared by Eastern for the original request. As such, the proposed amendment complies with the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act. No further environmental review or documentation is necessary for your Board to act on this matter.

#### Board Committee Assignments

This letter was referred for action to The Water Problems Committee because of its authority to review and consider requests for annexation, pursuant to Administrative Code Sections 2481(g) and 3102.

#### Recommendation

#### Water Problems Committee for Action

That the Board adopt the transmitted resolution which amends Resolution 8300 and reaffirms the granting of Eastern's request for consent to the concurrent annexation of the Forty-Sixth Fringe Area to Eastern and Metropolitan, upon the terms and conditions fixed in Resolution 8300 with the exceptions that the completion date shall be on or before December 31, 1992 and that the annexation charge will be recomputed pursuant to Section 3300 of Metropolitan's Administrative Code if the Per Acre Rate is revised prior to completion of this annexation.

## RESOLUTION 8347

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF  
THE METROPOLITAN WATER DISTRICT  
OF SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA  
AMENDING RESOLUTION 8300 CONSENTING  
TO THE ANNEXATION OF FORTY-SIXTH FRINGE AREA  
UPON CONCURRENT ANNEXATION THEREOF  
TO EASTERN MUNICIPAL WATER DISTRICT  
AND FIXING THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF  
SAID ANNEXATION TO  
THE METROPOLITAN WATER DISTRICT OF  
SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA

A. WHEREAS, on January 8, 1991 the Board of Directors of Metropolitan adopted Resolution 8300 consenting to the annexation of Forty-Sixth Fringe Area, upon the concurrent annexation thereof to Eastern Municipal Water District and fixing the terms and conditions of said annexation to Metropolitan; and

B. WHEREAS, subsequent to that action, certain events have forced a delay in the progress of this annexation;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Directors of Metropolitan reaffirm all of the terms and conditions contained in its Resolution 8300, except that Section 1 thereof be amended to read:

"Section 1. The annexation of said area to Eastern shall be made concurrently with the annexation thereof to Metropolitan, and all necessary certificates, statements, maps, and other documents required to be filed by or on behalf of Eastern to effectuate the annexation shall be filed, as required by law, on or before December 31, 1992. If the Per Acre Rate is revised prior to completion of the annexation, the annexation charge will be recomputed using the new rate pursuant to Section 3300 of Metropolitan's Administrative Code."

C. BE IF FURTHER RESOLVED that the Executive Secretary be, and she hereby is, directed to transmit forthwith to the governing body of Eastern a certified copy of this resolution.
