*Subject:* Continuance of Seasonal Storage Service

Report

In addition to encouraging groundwater storage through the 1993 Demonstration Local Storage Program, Seasonal Storage Service will be continued past the usual ending date of April 30. According to Section 4514 of the Administrative Code, the General Manager may make this service available at other times of the year at his discretion.

In order for an agency to qualify for the Seasonal Storage Service (SSS) past April 30, the following conditions will need to be met:

- For in-lieu SSS, an agency must purchase at least the same amount of noninterruptible water as in the corresponding month of calendar year 1992.
- For reservoir SSS, an agency must demonstrate that a reservoir has a net gain in storage compared to the corresponding month of calendar year 1992. The qualifying SSS amount will be limited by the purchase of Metropolitan water during that month.
- A subagency will not be allowed to participate in SSS and the 1993 Demonstration Local Storage Program at the same time.


Adjustments of the qualifying criteria may be necessary on a case by case basis for those agencies with special circumstances.
