BIOGRAPHY

CAROLYN L. GREEN

Carolyn L. Green is the Director of Government and Public Affairs for Long Beach, California-based Ultramar Inc., the state's largest independent oil refiner/marketer. She develops and administers all corporate public and government affairs policy and outreach activities.

Ms. Green joined Ultramar in October 1991, after serving for three years as Deputy Executive Officer for Public Affairs with the South Coast Air Quality Management District, based in El Monte, California. In that position she was responsible for the agency's public information and outreach, media liaison, intergovernmental affairs and transportation management programs. She joined the AQMD in November 1987 as Deputy Executive Officer for Planning and Analysis, where she oversaw the development and adoption of all agency rules and regulations, as well as the Air Quality Management Plan, the region's first-ever ozone/carbon monoxide attainment plan.

From 1984 to 1987, Ms. Green served as Environmental Affairs Manager for Southern California Gas Company, the nation's largest natural gas distribution company. In this capacity she was the primary Company spokesperson with local, state and federal environmental and land use regulatory agencies, and on state and federal environmental legislation. She also was responsible for developing corporate environmental policy. She joined SoCalGas in late 1982.

From 1977 to 1982, Ms. Green was Manager of Policy Planning with the Jack G. Raub Company, where she managed the issues management and governmental affairs programs for the Raub and Mission Viejo companies. She conducted environmental, transportation, land use and growth management policy analysis for the planning and development of Aliso Viejo, California, a 20,000-home new community owned by the Mission Viejo Company.

Ms. Green began her career as a planner with the California Air Resources Board, where she worked from 1974 to 1977. She was the youngest member of a seven-person team that developed the air quality management planning process for the State of California, the first such program in the nation. She also co-authored an air quality planning handbook for use by local land use and transportation planners.

A native of Iowa, Ms. Green earned a Bachelor of Arts degree in music and social sciences from the University of Iowa in 1973. She spent a year as a HUD Urban Studies Fellow in the Graduate Program in Urban and Regional Planning at Iowa in 1973, and completed a course in urban planning and public policy at the University of California, Berkeley, in 1975. She is a member of the American Institute of Certified Planners.
