There were three construction contracts awarded during the month. The Board of Directors awarded a contract in the amount of \$15,219,400 to Kiewit Pacific Company covering site preparation for Henry J. Mills Filtration Plant Expansion No. 2 and a contract in the amount of \$2,569,690 to Tilden-Coil Constructors, Inc., covering the construction of the plant maintenance building and operations building annex at the Mills plant. The General Manager awarded a contract in the amount of \$34,785 to Pacific Southwest Roofing, Inc., for roofing renovation work for the Carbon Creek Pressure Control Structure.

There were two construction contracts completed during the month. Construction of the Etiwanda Control Facility and Reservoir was completed by the prime contractor, Advanco Constructors, on August 25, 1992, and Cass Construction, Inc. has completed construction of the Etiwanda Reservoir Emergency Discharge Conduit.

Contract No. 1410, in the amount of \$15,219,400, was awarded to Kiewit Pacific Company covering Site Preparation for Henry J. Mills Filtration Plant Expansion No. 2 and Contract No. 1411 was awarded to Tilden-Coil Constructors, Inc., in the amount of \$2,569,690 covering the Henry J. Mills Filtration Plant Maintenance Building and Operations Building Annex. A third Contract No. 1406, in the amount of \$34,785 was awarded by the General manager covering Roofing Renovation Work for the Carbon Creek Pressure Control Structure to Pacific Southwest Roofing, Inc.

Two construction contracts were completed during the month of August 1992. Construction of the Etiwanda Control Facility and Reservoir, under Contract No. 1370, was completed by the prime contractor, Advanco Constructors, and accepted by District forces on August 25, 1992. Contract No. 1394 covering construction of Etiwanda Emergency Discharge Conduit was also completed by Cass Construction, Inc., and accepted by District forces.
