Subject: Authorization to Enter Into An Agreement with Native American Tribes to Reinter Human Remains

Report.

At the meetings of the Land Committee and the Engineering and Operations Committee on January 10, 1994, the General Manager's recommendation as contained in the December 28, 1993 letter, was revised to read as noted below.

Recommendation

It is recommended that the Board of Directors authorize the General Manager to enter into an agreement, in form approved by the General Counsel, with the Pechanga Band of Luiseno Indians, the Santa Rosa Band of Cahuilla Indians, the Cahuilla Band of Cahuilla Indians and any tribal corporations formed by these tribes, to transfer ten acres of land, including minor facility improvements and an easement for ingress and egress thereto, for the reinterment of human remains unearthed during excavation and construction of the Domenigoni Valley Reservoir, and other Metropolitan projects and earth-disturbing activities in the region.
