Doyle is Past President of both the Southern California Water Conference and the California Water Resources Association, and has been an active member of the Water Resources Committee of the California Chamber of Commerce.

Doyle received the Outstanding Engineer's Merit Award from the Riverside-San Bernardino Branch of the American Society of Civil Engineers, and the Bureau of Reclamation Citizen's Award.

He is a two-time recipient of the National Water Resources Association's President's Award, and received NWRA's Life Membership Award.
