Subject: Write-Off of Uncollectible Cleanup Costs

Report

On April 23, 1993, a District Protective Services agent discovered an illegal dump consisting of debris from an unidentifiable demolished building on District property. Neither a third party property owner, nor a party responsible for dumping was identified by either Protective Services or the Claims Section of the Human Resources Division. Costs accumulated under Work Order No. 7-9839 for cleanup amounted to \$10,244.96. Pursuant to Administrative Code section 9201, the Board must authorize write-offs in excess of \$10,000.

Recommendation

It is recommended that the Board authorize the General Manager, with the advice of the General Counsel, to write off the costs in the amount of \$10,244.96.
