Senate Bill 466 (Leonard) -- Inverse Condemnation for Reduction in Property Value

Report

At its meeting, the Legislation Committee considered this Item. Concerns were expressed that Metropolitan should not be opposed to legislation that would curb excessive regulatory actions which reduce the value of private property. However, the Committee was also concerned that the bill, as written, would adversely affect legitimate government planning. In particular, the bill may create causes of action against Metropolitan for its project planning or rate setting activities.

As a result of the discussion, the Committee voted to seek amendments to the bill which would limit its impact to land use regulatory agencies, and to oppose the bill unless it is so amended.

Recommendation

It is recommended that the Board of Directors express their opposition to Senate Bill 466, unless it is APPROVAMMENDED to limit its effect to land use regulations.
