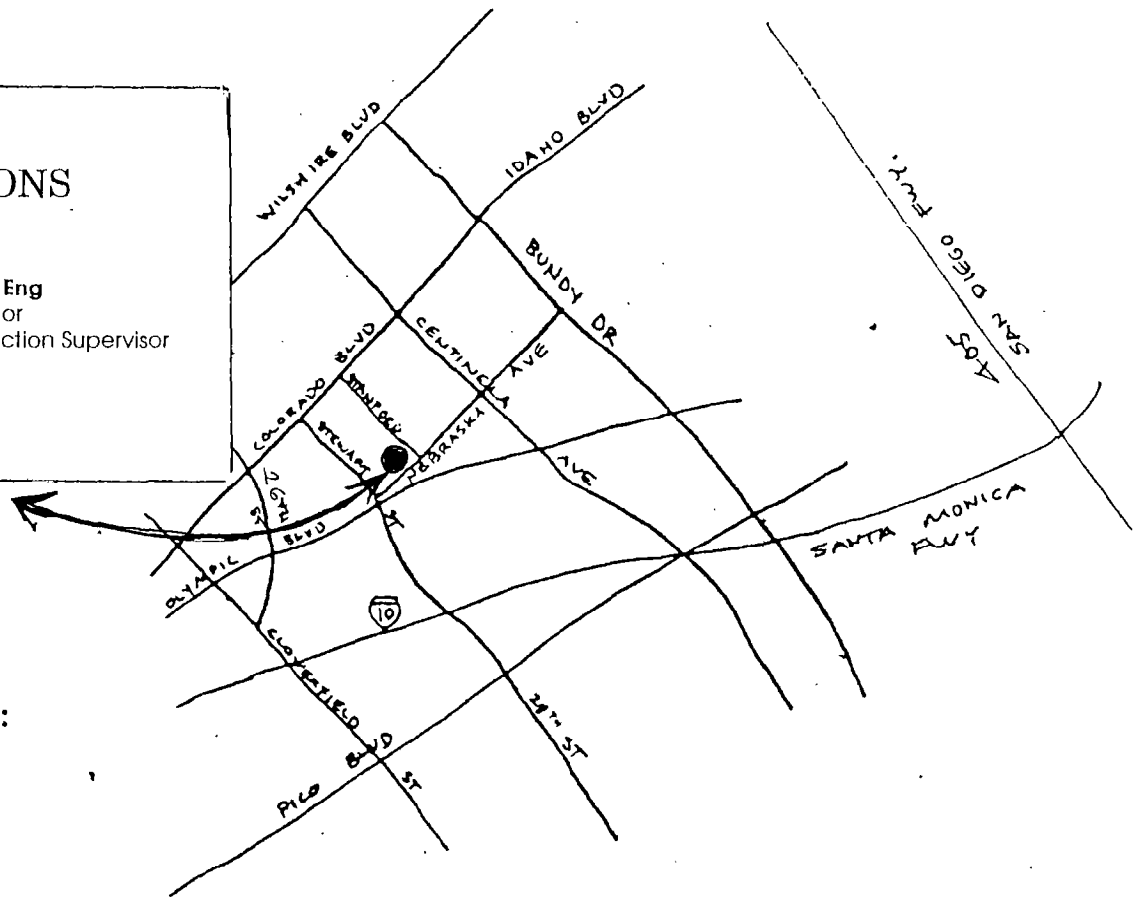

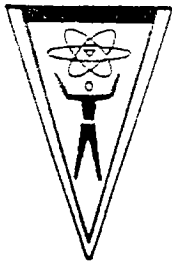

We are at present formulating a multi-prong fund raising non-profit program. 75% will go into water resource studies and 25% into health and other special projects. However health and water go hand in hand. We will be doing video film on the water project thru century cable in Los Angeles. We have already produced three health films and two product films in our program to up-grade technology.

Thru our meetings in Las Vegas, NV., concerning the Southern Nevada Water Authority and the Las Vegas Chamber of Commerce, we are using the Chambers VIP directory. A separate committee on water resources with the hotel and casino resort executives is now in the offering.

Also the So. Nevada Industry Directory will be in the offering for fund raising by a special committee.

The American Water Works Association of which I am an active member, I will be contacting many private AWWA exhibitors for funding. At the last AWWA Anaheim National Convention we have had excellent contacts.


At present we will be proposing a starter line to the CAN-AM water transport system. From Montana's lakes from the Rockies. A 600 mile line to the Green River in Wyoming min. 250,000 acre ft. for Las Vegas, NV. thru the Green River & Colorado River basin.

The canadian connection will come later. This study will give several alternatives with cost estimates and public/private bonds.

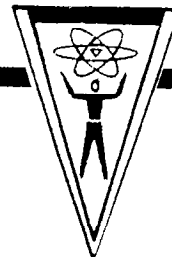
By 1997 the USA will encounter another seven year drought thru the established 11 year water cycle.
