Subject:Request to Authorize the General Manager to Enter into and Amend Existing<br/>Contracts with Employment Service Agencies and Consultants Supplying<br/>Temporary Personnel and to Employ Temporary and Part-Time District Personnel<br/>for the Engineering Division with an Overall Limitation in Amounts Paid of<br/>\$17,000,000 for the 1997/98 Fiscal Year

## **RECOMMENDATION(S)**

The Engineering and Operations and Organization and Personnel Committees have made the following changes:

It is recommended that the General Manager be authorized to amend existing contracts and enter into new contracts with employment service agencies and consultants supplying temporary personnel without regard to the \$250,000 limitation on the General Manager's contract authority. <u>No individual contract will exceed \$2,000,000 in a single-contract year</u>. It is further recommended that the General Manager be authorized to employ temporary and part-time personnel for the Engineering Division in addition to the Board-approved, District-wide personnel limit for Fiscal Year (FY) 1997/98, with an overall limitation in amounts paid of \$17,000,000 for FY 1997/98, substantially in accordance with the terms outlined in this letter, and in a form approved by the General Counsel. <u>Services provided by temporary personnel shall</u> be limited to the technical, engineering-related services listed on Attachment B of this letter.
