EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The eighteenth quarterly Project Status Report for the Eastside is provided as an Executive Summary, highlighting significant items of progress during the quarter ending December 31, 1997, and the current cost and schedule status of the project. Project details are available in the Monthly Status Report.

Highlights of this quarter included the issuance of the Notice to Proceed for Contract No. 1492, the Pressure Control Structure, and the issuance to bid for the North Rim Remediation and the Secondary Inlet contracts. Remaining contracts to be awarded are the Signal Spillway, Site Completion and Paving, Fencing, and the Recreation Facilities.

The West Dam, Saddle Dam, and Forebay contract with Atkinson-Washington-Zachry (AWZ) achieved seven percent progress this quarter, for a total of 58% percent completion. AWZ forecasted completion remains October 1999. The East Dam contract with Kiewit-Granite achieved a seven percent increase this quarter, for a total of 54 percent completion. Work has fallen behind schedule due to delays in the cutoff wall and a slow start on the foundation drilling and grouting program. Our forecast is for this contract to complete at the end of November 1999 although work-around efforts are being pursued to accelerate this schedule. The P-1 Pressure Tunnel contract with AWZ achieved 17 percent progress this quarter, for a total of 63 percent completion and is proceeding ahead of schedule. The P-1 Pumping Plant contract with Advanco Constructors achieved 11 percent completion this quarter for a total of 22 percent completion.


Work on this contract is slightly ahead of schedule. The Inlet/Outlet Tower contract with AWZ achieved nine percent completion this quarter, for a total of 12 percent completion. Work on this contract is continuing to fall behind schedule due to delays in the placement of concrete walls and foundations. The Pressure Control Structure contract with Advanco Constructors mobilized and achieved 2 percent completion for this quarter.

The design for both the Secondary Inlet and North Rim Remediation was completed this quarter and both of these were advertised for bids during this period. Design for the Signal spillway was also completed and issued to Department of Safety of Dams (DSOD) for review.










Construction Schedule




