ξ 2410. Membership.

The membership of the Executive Committee shall consist of the Chair, Vice Chairs, Secretary, all past Chairs of the Board who are directors of the district, eight additional directors as nonofficer members, of which two of the eight nonofficer members shall be appointed by the Chair, and the Chairs of the five standing committees in addition to the Executive Committee, as ex officio members. In the event a Chair of a Standing Committee is ineligible to serve on the Executive Committee because of the limitation set forth in Section 2210c, or is otherwise ineligible or is absent, the Vice Chair of the committee shall serve.

ξ 2410. Membership.

The membership of the Executive Committee shall consist of the Chair, Vice Chairs, Secretary, all past Chairs of the Board who are directors of the District, six eight additional directors as nonofficer members, of which two of the eight nonofficer members shall be appointed by the Chair, and the Chairs of the five standing committees in addition to the Executive Committee, as ex officio members. In addition, two additional nonofficer members shall be appointed as transitional members to the Committee by the Chair of the Board to serve from January 1, 1999 to January 1, 2000. In the event a Chair of a Standing Committee is ineligible to serve on the Executive Committee because of the limitation set forth in Section 2201(c), or is otherwise ineligible or is absent, the Vice Chair of the committee shall serve.
