Status report for the Inland Feeder Program for January 2002 [Any discussion of potential litigation to be heard in closed session. Conference with legal counsel – significant exposure to litigation (two matters); to be heard in closed session pursuant to Gov. Code § 54956.9(b)]

#### Description

#### **Arrowhead Tunnels**

Contractor bids were opened for construction of the Arrowhead Tunnels in early January. J.F. Shea Construction Inc. and Kenny Construction Company, A Joint Venture, was the low bidder at \$242.3 million. A request to award a contract is scheduled for the February Board meeting.

#### Arrowhead West Tunnel - Reach 1

Metropolitan has received the contractor's submittal of claimed costs regarding delay and deletion of mining. Staff has requested an audit of the contractor's financial records to substantiate these costs. The Board will be updated as information becomes available.

#### Arrowhead East Tunnel – City Creek Heading – Reach 2

The contractor continues construction of the City Creek Portal structure and has begun restoration of the surrounding site.

#### **<u>Highland Pipeline – Reach 3</u>**

The specifications were advertised for bid on January 8, 2002. Bid opening is scheduled for mid-March.

#### Riverside Badlands Tunnel – Reaches 5 & 6

The contractor continues to install the 60-foot sections of steel pipe in the tunnel. Through January, 35,107 feet have been installed. Grouting to fill the void between the primary concrete segmented liner and the steel pipe is being performed as the pipe is installed. All work is expected to be completed by November 2002.

#### **Budget and Schedule**

At the January 2002 meeting, the Board approved a pipeline connection between the proposed Inland Feeder Highland Pipeline and San Bernardino Valley Municipal Water District's Foothill Pipeline costing \$7.9 million. The connection will be funded through the program's Remaining Budget category. Accordingly, the projected total cost for the Inland Feeder Program has increased to \$988 million.

Claims associated with the deletion of work for the original Arrowhead Tunnels contracts are pending and excluded from the estimated total program cost. Staff is reviewing those claims.

Total expenditures through January 2002 are \$560 million (see **Attachment 1** for a financial summary/program cash flow and **Attachment 2** for a budget comparison and schedule summary/remaining budget). The board-approved budget remains unchanged at \$1.186 billion. The projected completion date for the program remains at early 2007.

#### **Recent Development**

On February 15, 2002, the last section of steel pipe for the RBT was installed.
