Status report for the Inland Feeder Program for activities through July 2004 [Any discussion of litigation to be heard in closed session. Conference with legal counsel--existing litigation (Shank/Balfour Beatty, a Joint Venture vs. Metropolitan Water District of Southern California, LASC Case No. BC 283438); to be heard in closed session pursuant to Gov. Code § 54956.9(a). Any discussion of potential litigation relating to the December 2003 Waterman Canyon Floods to be heard in closed session pursuant to Gov. Code § 54956.9(b)]

Description

Arrowhead Tunnels (new contract)

<u>Arrowhead East Tunnel</u> – As reported last month, tunnel boring machine (TBM) mining was halted on July 1 due to difficult ground conditions. The contractor is stabilizing the ground and making modifications to the TBM to enable the machine to mine through these conditions. The contractor estimates mining to resume in early August. Through July, 5,610 feet (25%) have been mined.

<u>Arrowhead West Tunnel</u> – TBM mining continued with a total of 225 feet being mined in July. A total of 1,415 feet (6.7%) has been mined to date. Minimal groundwater has been encountered, and is being successfully controlled through the grouting program.

Arrowhead East & West Tunnels – Reaches 1 & 2 (completed contracts)

At its May 2004 meeting, the Board approved a partial settlement of the pending litigation relating to the completed contracts. All claims of Shank/Balfour Beatty and its subcontractors Coast Geo and IAFD, as well as a pending Government Code Claim relating to the Riverside Badlands Tunnel, have been settled. The only remaining issues in the pending litigation are the claims by the pipe vendor, Ameron, in the amount of approximately \$11.5 million. On May 17, 2004, Metropolitan filed a cross-complaint against Ameron, alleging the submission of false claims. The trial is currently scheduled to begin on September 14, 2004.

Highland Pipeline - Reach 3

The contractor has completed all work and the notice of completion was filed in early June 2004.

Budget and Schedule

The projected cost for the Inland Feeder Program is \$951.2 million, excluding costs for settled/pending claims on original Arrowhead Tunnel contracts and the Highland Pipeline contract. Due to confidentiality of the recently settled claims with Shank/Balfour Beatty, the costs associated with these claims will be added to the Program's projected cost upon resolution of the Ameron claim.

Total expenditures through July 2004 are \$732.4 million (see **Attachment 1** for a budget comparison and schedule summary and **Attachment 2** for the Arrowhead Tunnels financial status). The board-approved budget remains unchanged at \$1.186 billion. The projected on-line date for the Inland Feeder is late 2007. Upon completion of construction, environmental mitigation measures will continue along the Arrowhead Tunnels alignment for up to two years in accordance with the Environmental Impact Report.

New Developments

<u>Arrowhead East Tunnel</u> – On August 10 the contractor began advancing the TBM slowly with the use of supplemental temporary "push" jacks and thrust beams. This method is currently being used with the TBM having advanced a total of 12 feet. It is anticipated that typical mining will resume upon 2 additional feet of mining.

<u>Arrowhead West Tunnel</u> – TBM mining continues with a total of 70 feet being mined in August (through the 17th).
