



Resolution for Annual Notice Potential Discontinuance of Surplus Water Service

Required by MWD Act Section 132

- Only IAWP water is surplus water
 - Replenishment is interruptible, but not classified by the MWD Act as surplus
- Surplus water may be discontinued in whole or part
 - 30% reduction in IAWP since January 1, 2008
 - 25% reduction in IAWP effective January 1, 2010, under Water Supply Allocation Stage 2
- MWD must provide 1-year notice
 - Notice necessary to reduce IAWP one year from now, even under a Water Supply Allocation

Next Steps

- Continuation of the IAWP reduction into 2010. Reduction drops from 30% to 25% as a result of the IAWP phase-out and Water Supply Allocation
- Agency notification letters will be mailed out to the three member agencies remaining in the IAWP before the end of October
- IAWP Reduction Guidelines will be updated and IAWP usage targets finalized after opt-outs are received by December 31, 2009

Resolution

- Not subject to CEQA
- Effective October 2010 – September 2011
- Passed by a two-thirds vote

Options

- Option 1: Adopt resolution
 - Allows for a reduction of IAWP in accordance with the Administrative Code and the adopted Water Supply Allocation Plan
- Option 2: Do not adopt resolution
 - Unable to reduce surplus IAWP water service to meet domestic or municipal uses, if necessary

Staff Recommendation

- Option 1: Adopt resolution
