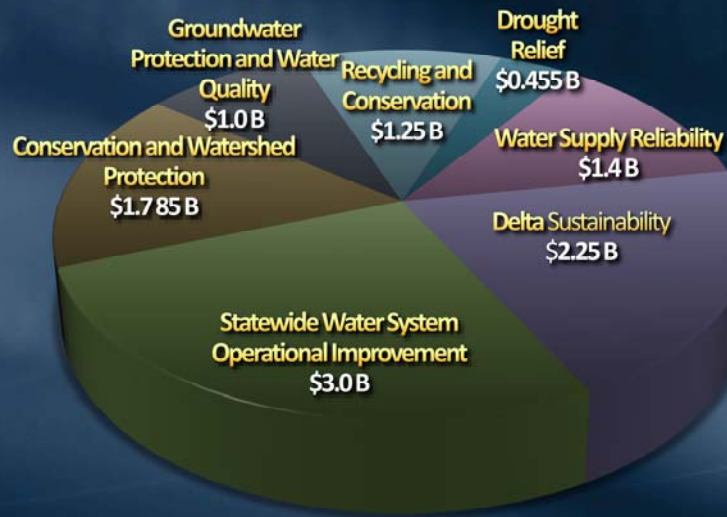

\$ 11.14 Billion



2010 Water Bond

Drought Relief - \$ 455 million



- Funds projects that can be completed in 2 years
 - Consideration for economically disadvantaged communities
 - Emergency water storage

Water Supply Reliability - \$ 1.4 billion



- Funds local and regional water projects
 - Water recycling
 - Local conveyance
 - Desalination

2010 Water Bond

Delta Sustainability - \$ 2.25 billion



- Funds public share of Delta restoration
 - \$ 1.5 billion for ecosystem
 - \$ 750 million for Delta counties and cities

2010 Water Bond

Statewide Water System Operational Improvement - \$ 3 billion

- Funds continuously appropriated
- Funds for public benefits only

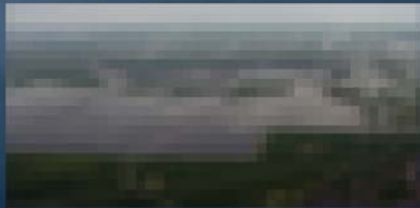

Conservation and Watershed Protection - \$1.785 billion



- Funds local and regional restoration, watershed protection, storm water management

Water Recycling and Water Conservation \$1.25 billion



- \$ 1 billion for new and existing recycling projects
- \$ 250 million for efficiency and conservation

- Funds projects that protect groundwater basins from foreign chemical and mineral intrusion
