Bay-Delta Conservation Plan MWD Objectives


- Multi-species approach to endangered species protection

- Habitat enhancements & conveyance improvements

Bay-Delta Conservation Plan Schedule

- End of 2010/Early 2011
 - Draft Conservation Plan
 - Draft Environmental Impact Report/Statement
- End of 2011/Early 2012
 - Final EIR/EIS
 - Permits



Delta Habitat Conservation/Conveyance Plan Supplemental Funding Amendment

- Reasons for supplemental funding
 - Additional project alternatives (including tunnel options)
 - Further hydrodynamic & operational modeling
 - Broadened environmental & biological analyses
- SWP funding collected in CY 2011 & 2012Statement of Charges



Original MWD commitment = \$38 million (DHCCP - \$35.0 M) Additional MWD commitment = \$25 million (DHCCP - \$21.5 M)

MWD total = \$63 million (DHCCP - \$56.5 M)

Delta Habitat Conservation & Conveyance Plan Supplemental Funding Amendment

- Contractual provisions
 - Planning agreement term through June 2012
 - 50/50 split between CVP/SWP
 - SWP costs allocated in proportion to Table A
 - If contractor withdraws from agreement, still responsible for task orders approved to date
 - Develop Project participation/allocation terms
 - Revenue bonds to pay for construction & reimburse planning costs if DHCCP is approved

Board Options

Option #1

 Adopt the CEQA determination and authorize execution of an amendment to the DHCCP Funding Agreement with DWR to provide up to an additional \$21.5 million for Metropolitan's share of costs
