



● **Third Quarterly Report of Consulting and Professional Service Agreements for FY 2009/2010**

Summary

Pursuant to the Administrative Code Section 2720(a), the 3rd Quarterly Report of Professional Service Agreements for FY 2009/10 is submitted in this report.

Exhibit D lists agreements terminated during the third quarter of FY 2009/10. The exhibits include agreements administered by the Legal Department for the General Manager.

Detailed Report

The amount expended on professional services during the third quarter of FY 2009/10 totaled \$16.2 million. 444 agreements were active with 41 agreements being terminated during the third quarter.

The Legal Department reported 50 active agreements during the third quarter of the fiscal year with no contracts terminated. These agreements are reported in a separate listing by the Legal Department, due to confidentiality.

There are no statutorily imposed procedures that Metropolitan must follow in selecting professional services consultants. Professional services are exempt from competitive bidding, and according to case law, should be awarded on the basis of qualifications and quality of work, not just cost.

Contracts not made as a result of competition were awarded in compliance with Administrative Code Section 8140, which exempts contracts under \$25,000; contracts for services whose rates are fixed by governmental regulation; contracts with other governmental agencies; contracts for insurance; or contracts where competition would not provide an advantage for the District.
