Purpose

- Mandated by the Urban Water Management Act
- Compliance will keep eligibility for DWR-administered state grants, loans, and drought assistance
- Plans must be filed with DWR every 5 years
- Act contains requirements for preparing report
 - Process
 - Content

Key Findings

● Process

- Collaborative process
- 60-day notification prior to public hearing
- Public hearing
- Board consideration

● Content

- Metropolitan has identified supply capabilities sufficient to meet expected demands
- Metropolitan has comprehensive plan for stages of actions to address reduction in water supply and catastrophic event
- Supply capabilities justified through current and future sources of supplies, efficient water use, demand management measures, assessment of water quality
