1st Quarterly Report of Professional Service Agreements for Fiscal Year 2010/11

Summary

Pursuant to the Administrative Code Section 2720(a), the 1st Quarterly Report of Professional Service Agreements for FY 2010/11 is submitted in this report.

Detailed Report

The amount expended on professional services during the first quarter of FY 2010/11 totaled \$14.4 million. 445 agreements were active with 33 agreements being terminated during the first quarter.

The Legal Department reported 43 active agreements during the first quarter of the fiscal year. The Legal Department's fiscal year expenditures totaled \$1.4 million with no contracts terminated. These agreements are reported in a separate listing by the Legal Department, due to confidentiality.

There are no statutorily imposed procedures that Metropolitan must follow in selecting professional services consultants. Professional services are exempt from competitive bidding, and according to case law, should be awarded on the basis of qualifications and quality of work, not just cost.

Contracts not made as a result of competition were awarded in compliance with Administrative Code Section 8140, which exempts contracts under \$25,000; contracts for services whose rates are fixed by governmental regulation; contracts with other governmental agencies; contracts for insurance; or contracts where competition would not provide an advantage for the District.
