



## • 3rd Quarterly Report of Professional Service Agreements for Fiscal Year 2010/11

### Summary

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Pursuant to the Administrative Code Section 2720, the 3rd Quarterly Report of Professional Services Agreements for FY 2010/11 is submitted in this report.

### Attachments

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The exhibits list agreements administered by the Office of the General Manager that were recorded as active during the third quarter of FY 2010/11. Under each exhibit, the agreements are listed alphabetically by the administering organization. Exhibit A lists active agreements that are under \$250,000. Exhibit B lists active agreements that are over \$250,000 per year. Exhibit C lists active agreements funded through outside grants. Exhibit D lists agreements terminated during the third quarter of FY 2010/11. The exhibits include agreements administered by the Legal Department for the General Manager.

### Detailed Report

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The amount expended on professional services during the third quarter of FY 2010/11 totaled \$8.9 million. There were 425 active agreements with 74 agreements being terminated during the third quarter.

The Legal Department reported 57 active agreements during the third quarter of the fiscal year. The Legal Department's fiscal year expenditures totaled \$1.1 million with four contracts terminated. These agreements are reported in a separate listing by the Legal Department, due to confidentiality.

There are no statutorily imposed procedures that Metropolitan must follow in selecting professional services consultants. Professional services are exempt from competitive bidding, and according to case law, should be awarded on the basis of qualifications and quality of work, not just cost.

Contracts not made as a result of competition were awarded in compliance with Administrative Code Section 8140, which exempts contracts under \$25,000; contracts for services whose rates are fixed by governmental regulation; contracts with other governmental agencies; contracts for insurance; or contracts where competition would not provide an advantage for Metropolitan.
