Summary

Detailed Report

The amount expended on professional services during the second quarter of FY 2011/12 totaled \$9.1 million. 341 agreements were active with 19 agreements being terminated during the second quarter.

A summary of each exhibit is provided in the following table.

The Legal Department reported 45 active agreements during the second quarter of the fiscal year. The Legal Department's fiscal year expenditures totaled \$896,146 with two contracts terminated. These agreements are reported in a separate listing by the Legal Department, due to confidentiality.

In accordance with Government Code Section 4536, professional service contracts must be awarded on the basis of demonstrated competence and the qualifications necessary for the satisfactory performance of the services required.

Contracts not made as a result of competition were awarded in compliance with Administrative Code Section 8140, which exempts contracts under \$25,000; contracts for services whose rates are fixed by governmental regulation; contracts with other governmental agencies; contracts for insurance; or contracts where competition would not provide an advantage for the District.
