a. Review of Bay-Delta Conservation Plan joint State/ Federal proposal

Mr. Stephen Arakawa, Manager, Bay-Delta Initiatives, reported on the Bay Delta Conservation Plan (BDCP) joint state/federal proposal announced July 25, 2012, by California Governor Jerry Brown, United States Secretary of the Interior Ken Salazar, and others. Mr. Arakawa presented video clips of the announcement, described the joint proposal, characterized the steps that lie ahead, and directed the committee's attention to the committee handout document, titled "BDCP California's Water Future."

Staff addressed questions and comments from the committee regarding cost estimates, the Integrated Resources Plan, funding, the timeline, the size of the forebay, new and existing State Water Project contract participation, and through-Delta surface flows.
