Foundational Actions Funding Program Objective

Help address regional funding needs for Foundational Actions, specifically technical studies, to reduce barriers to future water resource production

- Advance the field of knowledge for future water resource production
- Provide results that are unique, yet transferable to other areas in the region
- Represent a catalytic/critical path to water resource implementation

Foundational Actions Funding Program Overview

- Metropolitan will issue a Request for Proposals in 2013
- Agencies may submit multiple proposals, ranked by priority
- Agencies may partner with each other or outside entities
- Proposals will be evaluated by a review committee to ensure criteria are being met

Foundational Actions Funding Program Financial Overview

- Total funding estimated at \$3 million across all proposals
- Member Agencies may receive up to \$500,000 each
- A non-Metropolitan match of at least 100 percent of the Metropolitan funded amount required

Foundational Actions Funding Program Proposal Selection

- Review Committee
 - Panel of five, consisting of two Metropolitan staff and three external technical experts
 - Evaluate proposals based on criteria and program goals
- Selection Criteria
 - Reduces barriers to future water production
 - Regional benefit/applicability
 - Work Plan

Foundational Actions Funding Program Proposal Selection - Criteria

- Reduces barriers to future water production
 - Critical to resource implementation and planning efforts
 - Advances the field of knowledge for development of future water resources
 - Unique and innovative
 - Increases future local supply potential
 - Expedites future permitting or facilitates beneficial regulations
- Regional benefit/applicability
 - Applies to Member Agencies, retail agencies, regional stakeholders (transferable to other areas of the region)
 - May provide other benefits (energy, infrastructural, etc.)
- Work Plan
 - Clear that the proposed actions can be implemented
 - Objectives achievable on time and within budget
