Detailed Report

The amount expended on professional services during the second quarter of FY 2012/13 totaled \$16 million. Of the 342 active agreements, 21 were terminated during the second quarter.

A summary of each exhibit is provided in the following table.

The Legal Department reported 37 active agreements during the second quarter of the fiscal year. The Legal Department's expenditures during the second quarter totaled \$335,917 with no contracts terminated. These agreements are reported in a separate listing by the Legal Department.

In accordance with Government Code Section 4536, professional service contracts must be awarded on the basis of demonstrated competence and the qualifications necessary for the satisfactory performance of the services required.

Contracts not made as a result of competition were awarded in compliance with Administrative Code Section 8140, which exempts contracts under \$25,000; contracts for services whose rates are fixed by governmental regulation; contracts with other governmental agencies; contracts for insurance; or contracts where competition would not provide an advantage for Metropolitan.
