#### **Detailed Report**

The amount expended on professional services during the FY 2012/13 totaled \$41 million. This includes expenditures on both O&M work and capital projects, with the majority of agreements for capital. There were 415 active agreements with 86 of these agreements being terminated during the fiscal year.
