



- Filters designed 75 years ago do not provide robust performance needed today
- Internal components have deteriorated
- Full-scale evaluation of alternatives conducted





1. Filter Rehabilitation Scope

Contractor

Replace filter media, surface wash system

& underdrains

Raise & replace troughs

- Reinforce filter gullet walls
- Repair drain chutes

 - Public review period: Oct. 21 through Dec. 6, 2014
 - Mitigation Monitoring & Reporting Program (MMRP)
 - Statement of Overriding Considerations (SOC)
- Certification of final EIR
 - Compliance with CEQA & State CEQA guidelines
 - Board has reviewed & considered information
 - Reflects independent judgment & analysis
 - Adopt findings, SOC & MMRP
