


Adopt CEQA Determination and Approve Agreement to Provide Emergency Water Service for Tijuana, Mexico


Emergency water service has been provided to Tijuana, Mexico since 1972

- Provides water during interruptions and periodic supply inadequacies
- Previous agreement expired November 2013
- Mexico's water under Treaty up to 14,400 AFY
