


# Headquarters Datacenter Storage Upgrade


# Background




- Storage systems last 8 to 10 years

# Current 300 TB Data Usage




#### MWD Data Growth Forecast

- Procurement via "piggy-back" contract issued by using State of California, Department of General Services (DGS)
- Authorized under MWD Admin Code Section 8140 (1)(I)

- Certified Small Business Enterprise (SBE) and Regional Business Enterprise (RBE)
