#### **Current Action**

- Appropriate \$560,000
- Authorize relocation of equipment for Service Connections WB-2A & WB-2B on West Basin Feeder

# Background

- Inglewood Ave. & Manhattan Beach Blvd. intersection improvement, City of Lawndale
- Service Connections WB-2A & WB-2B:
  - Underground structure with flow meters & isolation valves – no modification required
  - Above-ground equipment with Automatic Meter Reading cabinets, air vent stacks & electric service cabinet requires relocation
- Enhances pedestrian safety



### Scope of Work

- Construction
  - Relocation of existing cabinets
  - Demolition, trenching, & concrete work
  - Extension of electrical service from Southern California Edison
  - Street closures & traffic control
  - Restoration of street surface
  - All work performed by Metropolitan forces



# Requested Funds

PM & permitting	35,000
Submittals review & record drwg.	19,000
Incidentals	27,000
Materials	70,000
Remaining budget	50,000
Total	\$ 560,000

Construction is expected to be completed in October 2018
