Current Action


 Award a \$53,273,196 construction contract to J. F. Shea Construction, Inc. to procure materials & perform construction for rehabilitation of portions of the Second Lower Feeder

Authorize an increase in change order authority to an existing procurement contract on the Second Lower Feeder

PCCP Management Strategy

- Continue regular inspection & monitoring
- Monitor stray currents & install cathodic protection
- Perform individual segment repairs as needed
- Plan & execute long-term rehabilitation of priority PCCP lines




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Contractor Scope


- Reach 2
 - Line approximately 24,000 ft. of existing PCCP
 - Furnish 9,200 ft. of pipe specials (small sections & transition points) & fabricated fittings
 - Replace all blow-offs, pumpwells, & air release valves
 - Provide traffic control
- Reach 3
 - Supply 12,750 ft. of 75-inch diameter steel liner pipe
 - Deliver to designated storage area





Metropolitan Scope

- Dewater line & return to service
- Fabrication inspection
- Construction inspection
- Submittals review & record drawings
- Coordinate temp R/W with local agencies
- Permitting, outreach,
 & program management

Federal Tariffs on Pipe Supply Contracts

Federal Tariffs imposed June 1, 2018
 25% on steel article imports

- Metropolitan contracts awarded before June 1, 2018
 - Tariff cost <u>not</u> included in bids
- Metropolitan contracts awarded after June 1, 2018
 - Tariff cost included in bids

Increase Change Order Authority

- Contract No. 1925 Pipe Procurement Reaches 2 & 4
 - Awarded to Ameron
 - Current Contract Value:
 - Estimated Tariff costs
 - Current C.O. Authority

May 8, 2018 \$12.1M \$ 2.2M \$0.25M

- Requested Action: Contract No. 1925
 - Increase change order authority by \$2.2M
 - New change order authority \$2.45M
 - New Contract value Not to Exceed amount: \$14.3M


