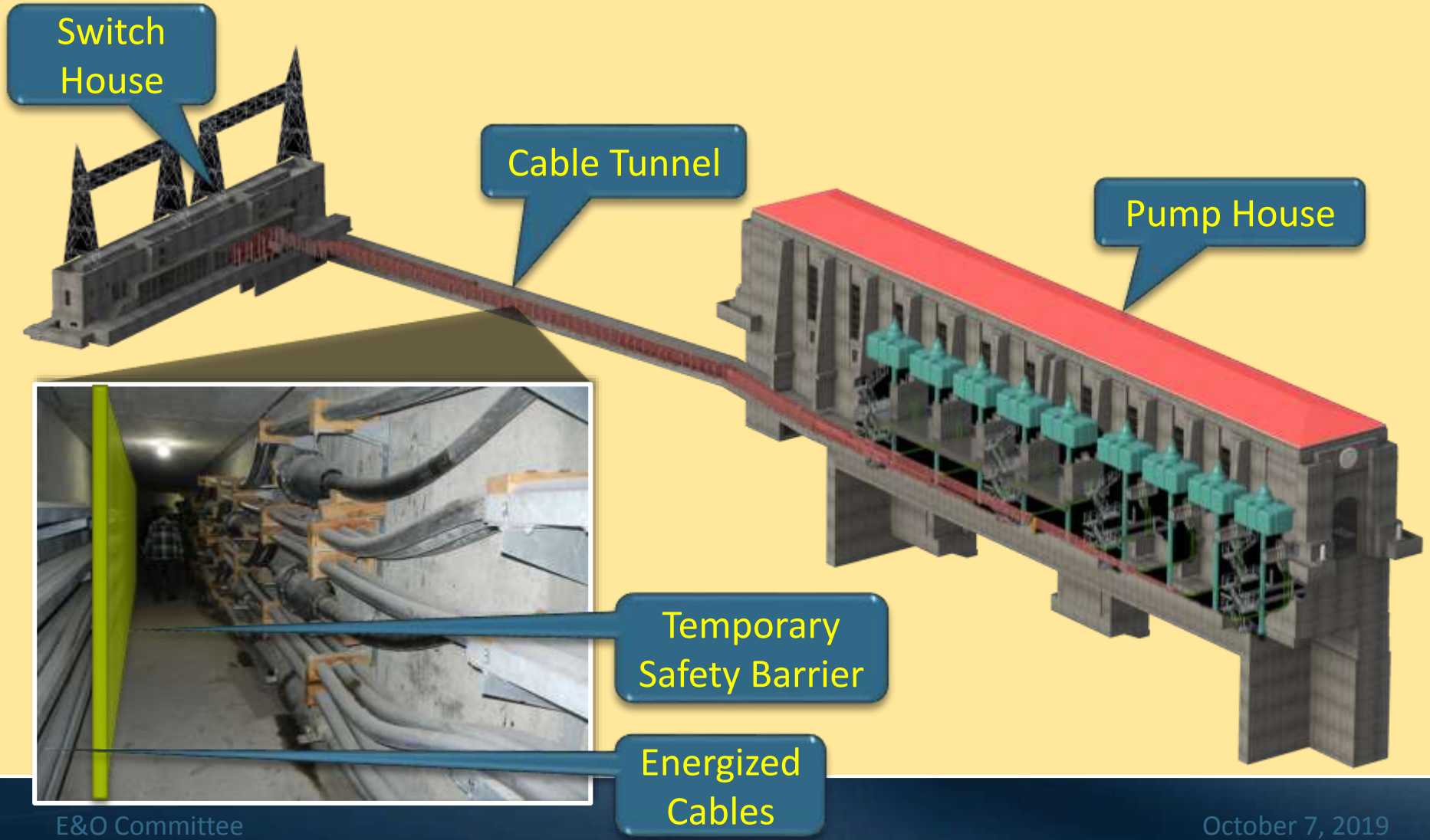

Current Operational Conditions

- 2019 SWP Allocation is 75%
- SWP blend targets are 85% at Weymouth and Diemer plants, and 75% at Skinner plant
- CRA is currently at a 3-pump flow
- Managing storage based on WSDM principles
- September 2019 deliveries of 164 TAF were 15 TAF higher than September 2018
- Maximizing deliveries of SWP supplies

CRA 6.9 kV Power Cable Replacement



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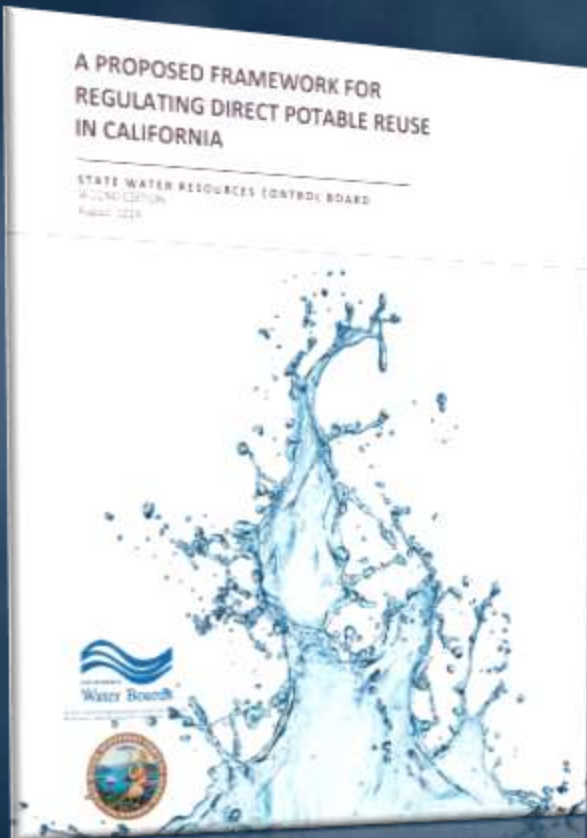
Regional Coordination on Chloramine Chemistry and Nitrification

Direct Potable Reuse Framework

- State Water Resources Control Board released a revised DPR Framework in August 2019



- Key updates to the DPR Framework include:
 - A single-regulatory package for all forms of DPR by the end of 2023
 - Consideration of drinking water treatment plants as part of a DPR treatment train
- Staff is finalizing comments to be submitted on October 9
