Paradox Valley Brine Disposal Well Begins Test Reoperation


- Prevents ~100,000 tons of salt from reaching Colorado River
- Shut down since last spring due to 4.5 magnitude earthquake
- In April, six-month pilot operation began
 Operate at 2/3 capacity
 Monitor seismicity



Reclamation Begins 2007 Interim Guidelines Review

 Term of Guidelines: 2007-2026
 Include shortage and ICS provisions

Seeking stakeholder input to evaluate effectiveness of Guidelines



Evaluation to be completed this year

Bard Seasonal Fallowing Began April 1

Nearly 3,000 acres fallowed

Land will remain out of production through August 1

About 6,000 AF will be saved
