Rate Structure Framework

- Flexibility
- Certainty
- Public Stewardship

- Regional Provider
- Financial Integrity
- Local Resource Development
- Imported Water Services
- Choice and Competition
- Responsibility for Water Quality
- Cost Allocation and Rate Structure

- Fair
- Based on the stability of MWD's revenue and coverage of its costs
- Provide certainty and predictability
- Reasonably simple and easy to understand
- Any dry-year allocation should be based on need

### Other Rate Refinement Items to Prioritize

- Readiness to Serve Charge refinements
- Capacity Charge refinements
- Rate re-bundling
- Surplus year storage incentives
- Revenue generating rates (monetizing storage including groundwater management replenishment program)
- Purchase Orders commitments
- Availability of Service charge
- Delta Conveyance Project cost recovery
- Regional Recycled Water Project cost recovery
- Metropolitan Reserve Policy
- Property Tax Alternatives
- Others
