Contracts

Within this past quarter, the General Counsel entered into or amended the following contracts pursuant to her authority under Administrative Code Section 6431:

Metropolitan retained Special Counsel to provide representation in the matter of *Oscar Renda Contracting, Inc. v. Metropolitan Water District of Southern California,* Riverside County Superior Court Case No. RIC1213525. The representation will involve working with the General Counsel's office to draft a pleading responsive to the complaint, handle discovery, assist with mediation and if there is no settlement defend Metropolitan at trial.
